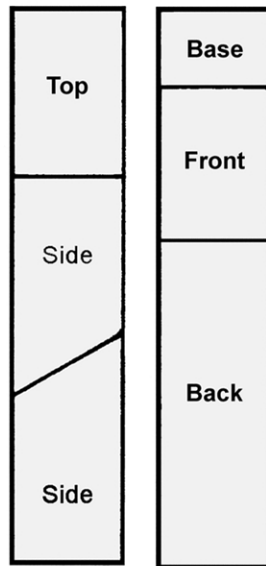


Box for Small Garden Birds - closed front, wide format design - Assembly Details

Fun with Learning Species Box Scheme FwL-SB-Bird6

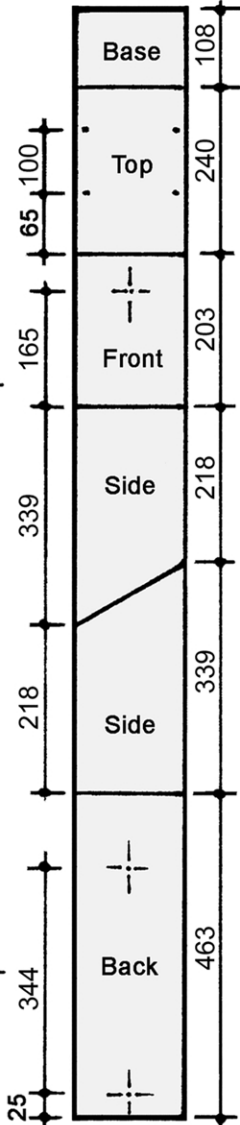


Cutting Diagrams

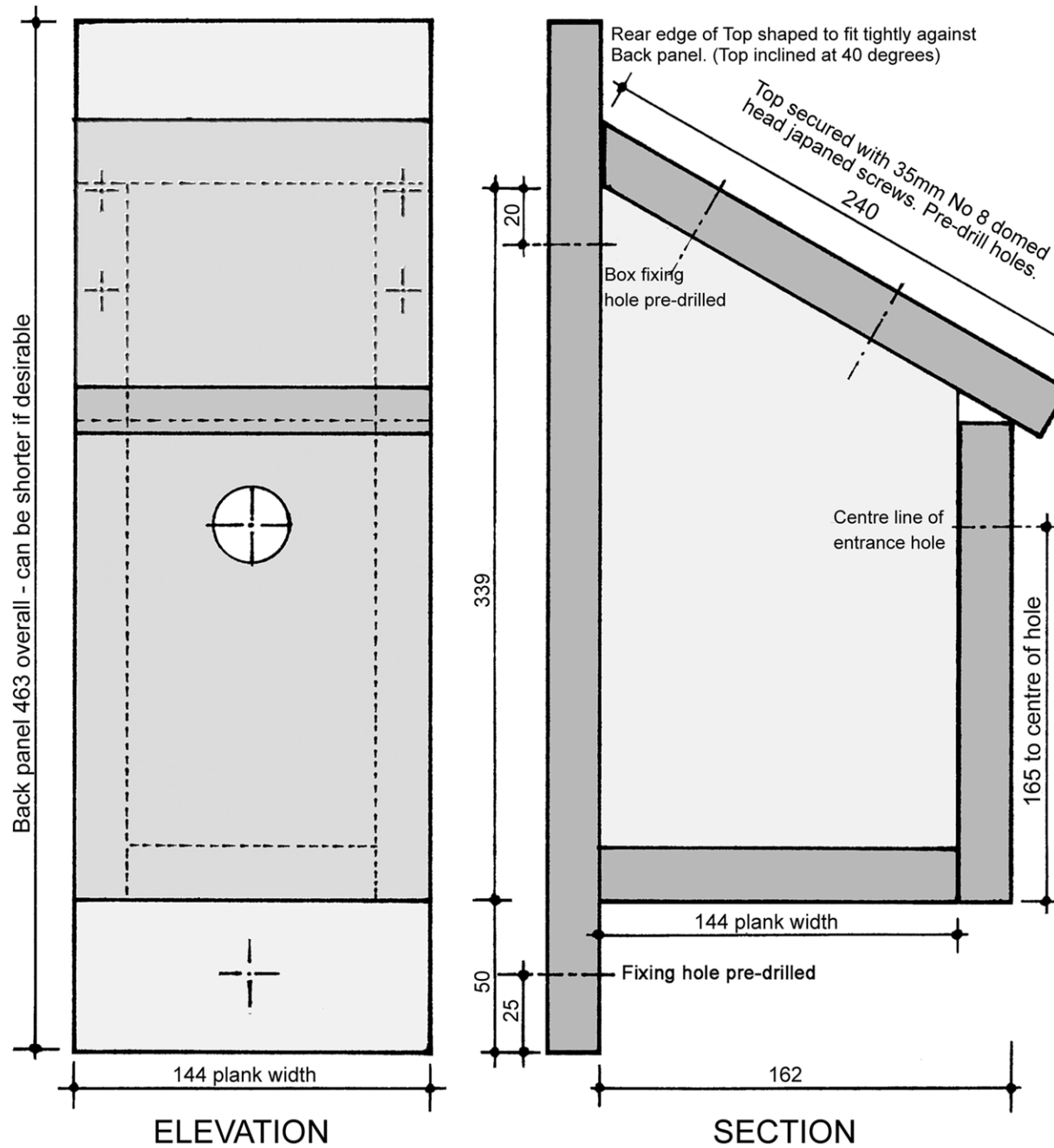


Notes:

- 1) Dimensions are finished sizes after cutting. 3mm allowance made for each cut.
- 2) Box must not be painted or coated with a spirit based preservative.
- 3) Entry hole size determines use. Diameters are-
25mm for blue, coal & marsh tits.
28mm for great tits.
32mm for sparrows and wrens.
- 4) pre-drill pieces for entry & fixing holes before cutting.
- 5) Assemble is with No 8 screws. Top fixed with dome japaned screws.
- 6) Remove top for fixing into position and for annual cleaning.
- 7) Box secured to walls/posts with 50mm No 10's. Secured to trees with bands or galvanized nails.
- 8) Design can be used for 'open front' boxes by changing front panel to create a slot.



Mark and cut progressively along plank from one end.
Off-cuts approx. 810mm.
Used for third box.



This design provides more floor space and a greater depth below the opening than FwL-SB-Bird1. It utilises two planks of 18mmx144mm pse x 2.4 m length timber to make three boxes. Offcuts are used to make the third box.
